Air Peace Corps Names General

Retired Air Force Brig. Gen. O. F. Lassiter has accepted membership on the board of trustees of UMATT—Dayton-based "flying Peace Corps" organization.

H. E. Ruble, chairman of the UMATT board, announced that Jane Hamilton of Dayton, chairman of the board of Dayton "Women for UMATT," has been elected vice president of the organization.

UMATT, Inc., chartered as a non-profit organization for humanitarian service, is successor to the United Missions Air Training and Transport, Inc.

THE ORGANIZATION owns six aircraft and provides free airlift service in six countries of East Africa, serving schools, agricultural cooperatives, medical stations, home crafts enterprises and irrigation projects.

Through funds raised by such groups as "Women for UMATT," the organization hopes to expand its air fleet to eight planes and to have 30 persons in the field instead of the present 15.

UMATT now serves the countries of Tanzania, Kenya, Uganda, Ethiopia, Malawi and Zambia.

Tax exemption for contributions is now being processed. In the interim, the University of Dayton is the tax-exempt recipient for funds designated for UMATT operations.

RUBLE, chairman of the organization's board, is vice president of Srepro, a Dayton electronics firm. Other officers are Mike Simae, vice president; James Smiley, president; Columbus Attorney Theodore Saker, secretary, and Brother R. Thompson, treasurer.

Lassiter, now president and

chairman of the board of Executive Jet Aviation, Inc., of Columbus, whose 25-year Air Force career ranged from flying P-38s and B-29s in World War II to chief of the USAF command post at Air Force headquarters.

SHELL SING FREE

DAR Won't Let Joan Use Hall

WASHINGTON—(AP)—Joan Baez, well-known folk singer, has been barred from performing in the Daughters of the American Revolution's Constitution Hall here, the Washington Post said in its Sunday edition.

Miss Baez, in response, has moved her show to another theater and decided to make it a free performance.

THE PAPER quoted Mrs. William Henry Sullivan, Jr., President of the DAR, as saying in Scarsdale, N.Y., that Miss Baez' reported activities aren't in line with our objectives.

"The DAR is very much behind our boys in Vietnam," Mrs. Sullivan added.

Miss Baez frequently has expressed opposition to the war in Vietnam and has refused to pay a part of her federal taxes, as part of that opposition.

Constitution Hall, with a seating capacity of 3,800, frequently

is used for major Washington cultural events.

MISS BAEZ is now to perform Monday night at the Sylvan theater, a public outdoor amphitheater near the Washington Monument.

Her manager, Manuel Greenhill, says the free appearance will cost Miss Baez some \$3,500 plus an estimated \$10,000 in receipts, the paper said.

Miss Baez performed in Constitution Hall in March, 1965. Tickets for that performance were sold out two weeks in advance.

Reached in Cleveland by telephone, the Post said, Miss Baez commented, "I guess the ladies would prefer we didn't sing there."

"BUT I don't want to go condemning the DAR. They do it out of the same kind of fear we all make our mistakes by."

The ban prompted her, she said, "to do the opposite—give a free concert—because it's so silly. I just hope members of the DAR will come."

Greenhill said the ban came in the form of a reply to his request for use of the hall some time in the latter half of this year.

Boy Clings To Sunken Boat, Saved

CLEVELAND — (AP) — A 13-year-old Cleveland boy was rescued Saturday after floating for an hour in Lake Erie about 1 1/2 miles off Edgewater park.

Michael Gordon, son of Mr. and Mrs. Basil Gordon, of 1883 W. 43th St., was with his father and three others on a fishing trip when their 16-foot outboard motorboat was swamped and the stern went under, dumping the five into the lake.

THE BOY stayed above the water and helped support them until first help arrived 30 minutes later.

Mr. and Mrs. Frank Dunn of Bratenahl arrived in their 22-foot inboard runabout and rescued four from the water, but Michael was too exhausted to climb aboard.

The boy remained afloat until a 26-foot inboard cruiser operated by Henry Eckhard of Westlake arrived. Eckhard, 34, dived into the lake and, with the help of his three passengers, got Michael into the boat.

The five were treated at St. John hospital and released.
