I have paid my debt to American Express in full and I overpaid \$50. I keep receiving statements reflecting the \$50 credit, but American Express won't send me the money. The credit doesn't do me a bit of good. Can you get them to send me \$50 in cash? — H. A. N.

You'll have to collect the \$50 from your wife. American Express in New York checked their records and found one of your credit card accounts is indeed overpaid to the tune of \$50. However, your wife's credit card is in your name too, and she owes American Express more than \$50. The company has deducted the \$50 from the balance due on her account, and her next statement will reflect the lower balance.

Before I buy another pair of boots you better believe I'll try both of them on. I tried on only the left boot of a pair I bought in Houston, and when I arrived in San Pedro Sula I discovered that both boots were for the left foot. I immediately sent back one of the boots and asked the store to replace it with a right boot. I got no reply. Should I just charge it off to experience? — Fred Nordstrom, San Pedro Sula, Honduras.



No, the shoe store is perfectly willing to refund the price of the boots if you'll return the other one too. When Action Line of The Houston Post called V. R. Hull, manager of Baker's Shoes, he said the wholesaler had mismatched your boots. The two right boots couldn't be located, and Hull was unable to find another mate in your size. He's mailed you a letter offering a refund, and we're sure he'll make it good.

One of the high spots of the movie "Cool Hand Luke" was a song entitled "Plastic Jesus" sung by Paul Newman. When I saw an album marked as the original sound track recording of the movie, I bought it and rushed home to hear "Plastic Jesus." I heard the music all right, but there wasn't a sign of a voice on the entire record. What happened? — B. B.

I'd like to know why the original sound track recording of "Casino Royale" didn't have the vocal of the theme at the end of the movie. I bought this album for the vocal, and I feel cheated that it isn't included. — Stella Glancy.

We were surprised to hear that vocals were left off original sound track recordings, but turns out it's not unusual at all. Recording friends in New York tell us movie singers often are under contract to one recording studio, while another studio records the sound track for their movies. In these cases, the singer's voice can't appear on the record unless his studio consents. Moral of the story is to read the album cover carefully before buying. If vocals are included, the singers will be listed as well as the song.

I am a fully rated commercial pilot interested in donating my services to a religious missionary group. I've heard of a group that uses airplanes to fly priests to isolated parishes in Canada and Alaska, and something along that line is just what I'm looking for. Can you put me in touch with such a group? — G. A.

Write to Brother Michael Stimac of the United Missions of Air Training and Transport-Wings for Peace (usually shortened to UMATT-Wings for Peace). The Catholic group, based at the University of Dayton, Ohio, maintains hospitals and schools in several underdeveloped countries. They have nine airplanes now, with more coming in a few months. You may be just the man UMATT needs, and Brother Michael has sent you a copy of their publication, "The Dove," to help you decide whether they're the kind of group you need.

I'm curious about the series of five beeps I sometimes hear on a television broadcast. I grew up around a radio station, and I remember that four beeps meant the next program would be a bulletin. Obviously my TV beeps don't mean the same thing, but I've noticed that the sound occurs more often during a crisis like the current Pueblo incident. Why? — Helen Buckley.

Because crises stimulate more messages, we suppose. Network news sources tell us the beeps are an air page, similar to the paging bells used by some department stores. It wouldn't do to interrupt a program with a voice page, so the beeps are used to let key people know there's a message or call waiting for them. The programming signals you remember are handled on TV by using coded shapes (such as squares, half moons and triangles) in the corners of the screen.
