## YMCA Membership Drive Chairmen Are Named

Evans Estabrook, a director of the Tyler YMCA, has been named chairman of the Y's annual membership drive set to start Feb. 1.

Bill W. Wallis, chief accountant for Texas Power & Light, will serve as vice-chairman of the drive.

He is a member of the Kiwanis International and served as president of the Richardson Kiwanis in 1960 and the Kiwanis Club of Tyler in 1968. In 1969, he was district secretary of the Texas-Oklahoma District of Kiwanis International.

He is currently serving as district chairman of finance, Texas-Oklahoma District of Kiwanis International.

Wallis is a member of the National Association of Accountants, the board of directors of the United Fund and the board of directors of the YMCA.

## Top Chilihead Haddaway Gets FAA Gold Medal

WASHINGTON (AP) — George E. Haddaway, editor and publisher of Flight magazine, Dallas, has been awarded the Federal Aviation Administration's highest honor, the gold medal for extraordinary service to aviation.

The FAA said Haddaway was cited for leadership in the encouragement of the growth of civil aviation. He helped establish Wings of Hope, a charitable organization providing aircraft and flight personnel for needy people in remote areas, and also was a founder of the Air Force auxiliary, the Civil Air Patrol.

Haddaway is founder and chief chilihead of the worldwide organization Chili Appreciation Society (International).
